Installing

Download the 'Anti-spam 1.0' installation file 'setup.exe' and run it. An MSI is available from support by contacting support@exclaimer.com.

Uninstalling

Uninstall can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' or MSI for the currently installed version of 'Anti-spam 1.0' or via 'Add/Remove Programs' in Windows Server 2003 or 'Programs and Features' in Windows Server 2008 and above.

The configuration files are located in the following folder and will not be removed as part of the uninstall process:

The uninstall process will not lose any of your configuration or settings. However as a backup precaution you may wish to export your configuration.

Export Steps

1. Open the Exclaimer Console
2. Select the 'Exclaimer' node
3. Open the 'Action' menu
4. Select 'Export Configuration...'
5. Select a location and filename for the export
6. Press Save

This will export all your settings including all your sender/recipient lists and licensing data.

Upgrading

Upgrading can be achieved by following the steps above to uninstall the current version and then install the new version. It is recommended to stop the Microsoft Exchange Transport service once Exclaimer Anti-spam has been uninstalled to prevent message delivery without Anti-spam protection. The installation of a new version of Exclaimer Anti-spam will start the Microsoft Exchange Transport service.
